NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Dogs must be registered with a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.
- There are no move-ups at this trial.
- This is a FUN-raiser trial. Proceeds go toward helping to support the annual awards program and the Championships each year. In an effort to keep entry fees to a minimum, no ribbons will be awarded.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- In the event of a weather cancellation of classes, there will be no refunds. You will receive a credit for any other FUN-raiser trial. If you choose to go home early, then you do not receive a credit for those classes missed.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

Non-Jumping classes – Veteran Handler:

Disabled handlers or handlers aged 60 yrs. or older may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive additional standard course time. This division is for handlers only. The additional SCT is for qualifying purposes only for those who may need the additional time to negotiation the course due to physical limitations. Veteran Handlers in the non-jumping classes will be scored and placed with their standard division jump height. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all classes and all dogs in this division for the weekend.

As of January-2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes ...

This is a Containerized Trial

FOOD/TOYS IN POCKET: Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a ziplock bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none can be left lying about loose. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over loose food or toys, diminish dogs dragging their handlers back to their crates (or wherever they left their food), and to lessen the amount of insects that are around loose food.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. Your dogs points can be found in the Members Section. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

DOUBLE RUN Format – For each course that is run twice in a day, the course is set, walked once, and then run. Following the completion of the first round, the second round is then run without a subsequent walk thru.

DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES: We will accept day of show entries provided the trial has not filled. The day of show entry fee is \$12.00 a run with no package deals.

Please Note: In order to receive the PACKAGE PRICE, you must submit payment on line or by mail prior to the closing date of the trial. You cannot enter the trial on line and then pay at the trial and receive the package price. When paying at the trial, the fee is \$12.00 per run.

In the event of a weather cancellation of classes, there will be NO refunds. You will receive a credit for any other Fundraiser. If you choose to go home early, then you do not receive a credit for those classes missed.

We will run on some type of schedule. If exhibitors come out and help then the trial runs quite efficiently. If no one helps, then as main workers get tired, the trial will run late and slow. We appreciate your help and thank you in advance.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

Directions:

New Hill is just south of the Triangle Area of North Carolina, and is less than an hour's drive from Chapel Hill, Durham or Raleigh. Autumn Winds Agility Center is on Bosco Road, the second right on Old US 1, going north from New Hill towards Apex. There will be dog show signs on the day of the trial.

From Chapel Hill or Durham - Take state Hwy 751 or 55:

- · Go south on 751. Go straight at the Hwy 64 intersection. Continue on New Hill-Olive Chapel Road until you reach the stop sign at New Hill. At New Hill, turn left onto Old US 1 toward Apex. Look for Bosco Road on your right.
- · Go south on 55, toward Apex. After passing the US Post Office in Apex, turn right at the first light onto Salem Street (which becomes old US 1) towards New Hill. Look for Bosco Road on your left, just before you get to New Hill.

From Raleigh:

· Go south on US 1, to the New Hill exit. Turn right at stop sign. The next stop sign is at New Hill. Turn right onto Old US 1, toward Apex. Look for Bosco Road on your right.
